THREE OPTIONS:

- 1. NEXUS CARD. APPLY ON-LINE WITH APPLICATION, PAY ON-LINE, BACKGROUND CHECK, INTERVIEW, PASSPORT PICTURE NEEDED AND GOOD FOR FIVE YEARS. EVERYONE ON BOARD MUST HAVE ONE. JOINT CANADA-US INITIATIVE. MUST PHONE IN WHICH SATISFIES LEGAL REQUIREMENT TO REPORT IN FACE TO FACE AT PORT OF ENTRY (SAULT STE. MARIE & DRUMMOND ISLAND)**
- 2. I-68 OR CANPASS. CAN APPLY ON-LINE, PAY ON-LINE, BACKGROUND CHECK, PICTURE, ISSUED A BR#. EVERYONE ON BOARD MUST HAVE ONE. MUST PHONE IN WHICH SATISFIED LEGAL REQUIREMENT TO REPORT IN FACE TO FACE AT PORT OF ENTRY.**
- 3. OARS PROGRAM USES VIDEOPHONES TO REPORT IN TO US CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION. THE SYSTEM IS COMPRISED OF AN AUTO-DIAL TELEPHONE, VIDEO TRANSCIEVER, A MONITOR, A FACIAL CAMER AND A DOCUMENT CAMERA. THIS SYSTEM ALLOWS THE TRAVELER AND OFFICER TO VIEW EACH OTHER AT INSPECTION. MUST SHOW PASSPORT. EVERYONE ON BOARD MUST HAVE ONE. WILL BE ISSUED A LOG#. LOCATED AT MAIN DOCK ON MACKINAC ISLAND.**

FAILURE TO REPORT CAN RESULT IN A CIVIL PENALTY OF \$5,000. IT COULD ALSO LEAD TO SEIZURE AND FORFEITURE. ALSO, A POSSIBILITY OF 1 YEAR IMPRISONMENT.
