Amendment No. 2 to Sailing Instructions

Section 16.1 is replaced in its entirety as follows:

16.1 Protests and Requests for Redress shall be decided by the Bayview Mackinac International Jury. Decisions of the International Jury will be final as provided in RRS 70.5. Protests shall be filed ~~in accordance with SI 16.3 on Mackinac Island~~ within three (3) hours of the finish of the protesting boat or no later than 1000 the following day if the protesting boat finishes after 2100. A withdrawing boat intending to file a protest shall notify the International Jury of her intent to protest when reporting her withdrawal. Protest by a boat that has withdrawn from the race shall be delivered to the International Jury at Mackinac Island within 24 hours of arrival at the harbor of **but no later than 0900 on Tuesday, July 23rd**. Protests may be filed online; ~~and~~ a link to the protest form will be available on www.bycmack.com under the Official Notice Board tab in the Registration area (click on 'Register/Owner Login'). Protests may also be submitted on a US SAILING Protest Form (available at both the Race Committee Skipper Check-In Desk and the Race Committee Headquarters at the Grand Hotel) **and shall be filed at the protest desk at Race Committee Headquarters at Grand Hotel**. In addition, **please** provide a cell phone number on the protest form in the event the Bayview Mackinac International Jury or the Race Committee needs to contact the protestor.
