SAFETY PROTOCOL

It is the responsibility of each skipper and each member of his crew to determine the vessel's and the crew's capabilities in the regatta. It is also the responsibility of all the competitors to give all possible help to any person in danger.

All vessels and their crew shall meet all applicable requirements set forth in the US Coast Guard Regulations, applicable class rules, the Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions, and the Racing Rules of Sailing.

It is the responsibility of each skipper and each member of his crew to understand the safety features and emergency procedures appropriate for the prevailing conditions.

All crew members should have such survival equipment at their disposal as shall be determined by the vessel's skipper and should be aware of the location of first aid provisions on board and the EMERGENCY NUMBERS (Page 2 of this document).

Each vessel should develop and rehearse emergency procedures including Man Overboard Drills.

Have a safe regatta!



ON THE WATER EMERGENCY

1. Call the USCG on VHF channel 16 or call the nearest USCG Station listed below and state that this is an **EMERGENCY**.
2. Give the following information:
 - a. Identify yourself
 - b. Boat Name, if applicable
 - c. Approximate Lat/Long of the boat
 - d. Type of emergency or injury (wound, injury to bones, muscles, joints or sudden illness, consciousness, etc.)
 - e. Is the injured person in the water?
 - f. M/F, Age
 - g. Advise if transport is needed.
 - h. Best assessment of the seriousness of the injury or illness as either: Non-Life Threatening Emergencies ----OR---- Life-Threatening Emergencies: i.e., stoppage of breathing, severe bleeding, heart attack, spinal injury, heat stroke, or seizure.

At this point, the competitor should follow instructions.
