NOTICE AND CONDITIONS OF RACE – Amendment 2

Section 2.1.j has been amended to give clarity on headsails regarding heavy weather jib with regards to ORC.

2.1.j Rules of the Offshore Rating Congress (ORC) shall apply for all monohull boats racing.

(i) A boat that is rated to carry a spinnaker may carry one more spinnaker than shown on her current ORC certificate of a type the boat is rated to carry and of an area not greater than the largest spinnaker area (SPA) without an increase in rating; however, a boat may not carry any spinnakers that are narrower than 85% half width/foot length unless such sails are declared and listed on a boat's ORC certificate.

(ii) Storm and heavy weather sails as specified in 2024-2025 Offshore Special Regulations 4.27 through 4.27.4 shall be excluded from the sail count when determining the number of sails each type that a boat is carrying aboard while *racing*.

This changes ORC Rule 206.1

Section 8.1, the location and hours of registration have been updated.

8.1.a Bayview Yacht Club: 1000 – 1900 hours on the Registration Date at Bayview Yacht Club in Detroit, MI.

8.1.b Port Huron Race Headquarters – Former Port Huron Central Fire Station, 515 River Street, Port Huron, MI: 0900 – 1600 hours on the Registration Date in Port Huron.

Section 12.2 has been removed.

12.2. ~~The two-turn penalty shall only apply for an incident that occurs within two hours of a boat's starting signal. This changes RRS 44.1~~
